Cafe / Tampa Museum of Art

The Tampa Museum of Art is home to *Sono Café*. Open seven days a week and overlooking the banks of the Hillsborough River, the café is accessible to all visitors through an admission-free entrance. The café offers a seating capacity of approximately 75, including waterfront tables, and features menu items appropriate to visitors of all ages. *Sono Café* embraces the 'Slow Food Movement, which counters fast food, and fast life, and invites guests to slow down and enjoy their dining experience with all the sensations that accompany the consumption of good food and quality ingredients in a comforting environment. The menu of *Sono Café* is rooted in Italy – where the concept of 'Slow Food' was founded in 1989 – and offers guests a range of choices from pressed panini's, salads, assorted gelatos, full coffee & tea bar, desserts, sparkling refreshments, and a selection of wines.

The museum offers exquisite spaces for weddings, corporate events, and meetings. Rental spaces include atrium receptions for 300-400 people, seating dining for 200-250 people, exterior gallery receptions that can accommodate 125 people, and meeting rooms to accommodate small to medium-size gatherings with a maximum capacity of 120 people. The meeting rooms are equipped with state-of-the-art technology, including modern audio/visual equipment and Internet access. As the exclusive catering operator, *Mise en Place* will provide all catering services for museum rentals and special events.

Museum Hours

The museum opens daily at 11 a.m., and *Sono Café* operates during regular museum hours. The hours of operation are: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday from 11 a.m. – 7 p.m.; Thursday from 11 a.m. – 9 p.m.; and Saturday and Sunday from 11 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Museum Admission

General admission prices are as follows: adult admission \$10; seniors, groups, military plus one guest \$7.50; students \$5; and children ages 6 and under free-of-charge. A “pay what you will” fee structure will be offered every second Saturday of the month from 9 a.m. – 11 a.m., and every Thursday from 5 p.m. – 9 p.m.
